# "PSW for Psychologists: New Hires and PSW Novices- CHC and Dual Discrepancy/Consistency Method (Cross-Battery Assessment)

**Prerequisite:**

Participants will be required to complete *Dual Discrepancy/ Consistency Method of PSW for Beginners*, a free self-paced online course, prior to attending this workshop. Once registered, a link will be provided. The course will take approximately 3 hours. Please ensure that you schedule adequate time to complete the prerequisite course prior to the first training date.

Please download the PSW Manual from the VC SELPA website prior to the training. You don't need to print it out; just please have it available on your device so that you may access it during the training.

**Workshop Description:** This will be a 1.5-day workshop. The first day will take psychologists through the 10 steps of the Ventura County PSW Assessment Model with an emphasis on incorporating the use of the Dual Discrepancy (AKA: Cross Battery Assessment) Model throughout a psychoeducational assessment for SLD. The most recent version of the corresponding software will be reviewed, and training will be provided on integrating assessment results into a comprehensive psychoeducational assessment report.

The half day follow up training will take place approximately 2.5 months later once psychologists have had the opportunity to use the PSW model on real cases at their school sites. Presenters will run through more complex case studies and allow participants to work through each using software, problems solving skills and clinical judgment.

For districts utilizing the Cross-Battery approach, access to the *Essential of Cross Battery Assessment-Second Edition* and the X-BASS software are recommended. Participants are strongly encouraged to bring a laptop with the most updated version of the X-BASS software (Wiley.com) to participate in the hands-on case study activity.
